



Emergency Vehicles



Pull to right and stop

Move to right of lane or shoulder

Always slow down and cover the brake

Exception?

State law requires drivers approaching a stationary authorized emergency vehicle, including a tow truck and TX DMV vehicles and workers, using approved visual signals, and traveling in the same direction, to reduce speed (not to exceed 20 mph less than a posted speed limit of 25 mph or more, or not more than five mph when the posted speed limit under 25 mph) and vacate the lane closest to the emergency vehicles.

Resolution No. 67-13

September 11, 1967

RESOLUTION

No. 67-13

WHEREAS, the Texas Highway Department has authorized the construction of State Highway 289 from a point North of F.M. Road 1461, North to F.M. Road 455; and

WHEREAS, State Highway 289 will then be located approximately 0.4 mile East of the present location of said highway; and

WHEREAS, it is desired that the State Highway Department provide a connection in Celina from the present location of said highway to the proposed location of Highway 289, which will be a distance of 0.4 mile; and

WHEREAS, such construction has been authorized by Highway Commission Minute No. 59895, dated August 31, 1967, provided the City of Celina, Texas accepts the provisions of said Minute Order No. 59895; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Celina, Texas, in a special meeting on this, the 11th day of September, 1967, that the City Council of the City of Celina, Texas does accept the provisions of Highway Commission Minute No. 59895.
